Past perfect tense - English for Everyone

The past perfect (progressive) tense is used to describe an action that was happening before another past action It is also used to describe an action that was happening in the distant past • Use the helping verb phrase “ had been” before a verb in past perfect progressive tense to describe all subjects (I, we, you, they, he, she, it)

Main Rules for Simple Past vs Present Perfect 1 Simple Past: use for past events or actions that started & ended at a specific time / are not connected to the present 2 Present Perfect: use for actions which started in the past and continue to present -or- for completed actions that are

•Past Perfect emphasizes that we are talking about a period before a time in the past If the time sequence is clear (eg because we use after), both Past Simple and Past Perfect are possible At other times Past Perfect is essential to understanding the sequence, and ...
